


# How to read this Trackbook

## In general

This Trackbook is build up like a Roadbook. That means every junction on the road has a symbol, showing where you are, what you expect or where you should go. But lets explain it with an example:



## Specific symbols and their meaning

| <p>Fist symbol of a track<br/>Leaving F338 to S</p> | <p>Last symbol of a track<br/>Arriving at R365</p> | <p>Road entering from the left, go straight</p> | <p>Turn right</p>   |
| <p>Bridge</p>                                       | <p>River crossing and depth</p>                    | <p>Gate</p>                                     | <p>suitable</p>     |
| <p>Reset speedo to 0.0</p>                          |  |   | <p>NOT suitable</p> |
