After the bridge over Jökulsà à Fjöllum was built, the F910 has become a very popular route on the way from the ferry straight into the highland. On dates around the ferry's arrival it gets quite busy. It is a good alternative to Route 5 (F88) and most of the time is still passable when F88 is closed due to flooding. The two river crossings have firm ground and are easy to pass.
